

And be it further enacted by
 the authority aforesaid and with the Advice and Consent of
 that all persons whether Inhabitants or Forreiners shall
 repair and bring their Bullard with them by they w^{ch} they w^{ill}
 and receive their Tolls by the Standard yearly and every
 year to be tryed Stamp and Tinselled for which they
 are to pay the p^{er}son keeping the Standard one Shilling
 for every time such Standard shall be tryed and Stamp
 as aforesaid and every person or persons shall have their Bu^{ts}
 of a Gallon full of Quert and pint if they make use
 of the same or any of them in buying or selling any
 tryed and Stamp at the Standard of Great Brit^{ain}
 the Measures as as come out of England and are
 there Stamp for which trying and stamping they shall
 pay p^{er} p^{er}son a p^{er}ce

And whosoever shall presume to sell
 by any dry measures without first having the said mea-
 sures tryed and Stamp at the Standard shall forfeit
 the sum of five hundred pounds of T^o

And whosoever likewise shall presume
 to weigh and receive Tolls by Standards which have not
 within one year past from such weighing and receiving
 been tryed and Stamp at the Standard shall forfeit one
 thousand pounds of T^o the one half of which aforesaid
 mentioned forfeitures to be paid to his Majesty his heirs
 and Successors towards the Defraying the Charge of
