

Indians out of this province

**Be it Enacted** by the King, most Excellent Majesty by and with the Advice and Consent of his Majesty's Governour, Council and Assembly of this province and the Authority of the same that from and after the publication hereof any person or persons whatsoever inhabiting or Trading into this province that shall presume to carry any Goods whatsoever to any Indian Settlement or Town and shall vend or Dispose of the same to any Indian or Indians whatsoever such person or persons shall forfeit the sum of five thousand pounds of good and lawful money to our Sovereign Lord the King his heirs and Successors towards the Support of Government the other half to him or them that shall Inform or sue in the same to be recovered in any Court of Record within this province by Action of Debt Bill, Plea or Information whereunto no privilege protection or waiver of law to be allowed and whereas it is represented to this Honourable Assembly that of late years Disorders and riots have been committed by drunken Indians in Order to prevent such like future Mispractices and Outrages

**Be it Enacted** by the Authority, Advice and Consent aforesaid that if any person or persons whatsoever from and after the end of this present Session of Assembly shall by himself or herself or otherwise
