

158 And signours bid them for such Gunnes or Matchcoales no  
shall any of his Majesties Subjels whatsoever Trust  
any Indian or Indians for signours or take any pawn  
or pawn from them on any pretence whatsoever on  
paine of forfeiting their debt for such signours so credite  
ed to the Indians as if they being obliged to receive  
the Indians pawns as if without any reward or  
satisfaction therefore any Law Statute Wage or  
Custom to the contrary notwithstanding.

And to the end that no breach of peace may happen  
between the Neighbouring Indians and the Inha-  
bitants of this province.

It is enacted by the Authority aforesaid  
that any person or persons whatsoever that shall  
take any Indian or Indians by force or violence to  
be sold or transported out of this province or otherwise  
Dispose of any friend Indian or Indian whatsoever  
or attempt or endeavour to do so without license from  
the Governour for the time being and all such persons shall be  
punished and imprisoned at the discretion of  
the Governour and Council for the time being and that  
any person or persons whatsoever that shall Injure  
against or commit any offence to be appre-  
hended shall have such satisfaction therefore as the  
Governour and Council shall think fit.

And it is further enacted that the
