

Such Defendant shall be released with two sufficient  
 freeholders of this province, who as the Justice or Justice  
 before whom the Defendant shall go shall approve of  
 and then and there give special bail to the condition  
 wherein he shall be so released by virtue of such writ  
 which bail so taken shall be delivered to the Sheriff  
 of such County where the same is taken to be by him  
 returned with the said writ to the provincial Court.

And be it further enacted by

the Authority aforesaid with the Advice and Consent  
 of that Honorable special Bail is required in the pro-  
 vincial Court by the plaintiff's Attorney at the call-  
 ing over the appearance docket, and that the sum  
 of the rule special Bail shall be given and the party  
 against whom the rule is given that he shall give  
 special Bail to present the party Defendant at that  
 time and there give special Bail to the Defendant  
 and shall be delivered to the Sheriff of the County  
 that arrested him in that condition to give spe-  
 cial Bail to the Defendant of the said party Defendant  
 to not able at the time that he is to present the  
 special Bail then the said party Defendant is to  
 be taken in the custody of the Sheriff of that County  
 and by him in safe custody kept and  
 carryed back into the County where the Defendant  
 was arrested and there in safe custody kept
