

162 To the Honorable the Justices of the provincial Court which
said recognizance of baile so taken as aforesaid shall be trans-
mitted to the Justice of the said provincial Court sitting
when and where he shall think fit that he depending
logically with respect of attorney fees by the said
Defendant be given to the said Justice or any one of
the Justices of the provincial Court as aforesaid recognizance
of baile the same as if the said Court shall receive upon
an appeal in law for the said Defendant by any
one of the attorneys of the said Court pursuant to such
warrant having to the said Justice their fees and
costs as have been received for the taking of such baile
in law and shall be of the force and effect as if
the same were taken in de bene esse before the Justices
of the provincial Court during the absence of the
Justice and the recognizance of baile shall be taken of the
provincial Court or president or any two Justices of
the County Court which take such baile shall re-
ceive only the value of such baile and no more

And to be further enacted by the
authority aforesaid the Justices of the provincial Court shall
make such rules and orders for the taking of such
baile and making the same absolute as to whom
shall be permitted to give the recognizance of such baile
or baile to be compelled to appear in person in the
provincial Court to justify him or themselves - and
