

the thirteenth day of the month of November in the year of our Lord one thousand six hundred and seventy four or thereabouts shall be set out and enrolled shall be good and available in law with all force and effect. And whereas in the year of our Lord one thousand six hundred and seventy four in the fourth year of the Dominion of the right honorable Charles second Baron of Baltimore a very good law was made whereby it was enacted by the said King Charles second by and with the advice and consent of the upper and lower houses of the then then assembled that no man nor woman nor child nor apprentice and servants whatsoever within this province should alter or change from one to another as by the said act relation being therein to had more at large doth appear except the same were acknowledged and enrolled as in the said law is directed.

Be it therefore hereby declared and enacted by the authority aforesaid and consent that whatsoever Deed or Deeds Conveyance or Conveyances during the continuance of the said law were enrolled by virtue of the said law within the time therein limited are and shall be taken and adjudged to be good and lawful according to the purpose intent and meaning of such Deed or Deeds Conveyance or Conveyances made and if any Deed or Deeds Conveyance or Conveyances made during the continuance of that act were called and delivered but not enrolled according to the intent of the said law
