lawful by. with deed or deed conveyance or conveyance  
not enrolled as aforesaid the repeal of the said Law notwithstanding  
standing

And whereas it is especially heard  
at the city of. . . . .  
Anne Dominion one thousand six hundred ninety two  
in the fourth year of the reign of our late sovereign  
Lord and lady King William and Queen Mary of blessed  
memory the Act for Enrolment of conveyances and  
securing the States of purchase was then made which  
by it was enacted that no man nor lands Tenement  
or Hereditament whatsoever within this province shall  
pass or be a change from one to another whereby the  
state of Title or Interest or Right or Estate shall take effect  
as by the said Statute being returned had since  
at large doth appear except the deed or deed conveyance  
or conveyance by which the same were intended to pass  
after a change from one to another were acknowledged  
and enrolled as the said Law Directs

We it hereby enacted and Declared  
by the authority aforesaid and consent of the said  
Deed or deed conveyance or conveyance during the  
continuance of the said last mentioned Act were en-  
rolled by virtue thereof within the time therein  
limited are and shall be taken and adjudged to be
