

her or her heirs except upon her Acknowledgment  
of the same and the person or persons taking such  
her Acknowledgment shall examine her privately  
out of the hearing of her husband whether she  
doth make her Acknowledgment of the same willing-  
ly and freely and without being induced thereto  
by fear or threat or of ill usage by her husband  
or fear of his displeasure and that the person or  
persons so examining her shall in a note or certifi-  
cate of the taking of the said Acknowledgment  
certify her Examination and Acknowledgment  
thereupon and that such Certificate be likewise  
enrolled upon Record in which case and by such  
Acknowledgments and Certificates some Courts  
shall be barred and not otherwise and that no Court  
be barred of their power by such like Acknowledgments  
where they have only a right of Power in the State  
conveyed all this notwithstanding in the Face thereof of any  
thing therein contained to the contrary notwithstanding  
— — — Provided always and to be further  
enacted by the Authority aforesaid with the Advice  
and Consent of that which any Acknowledgment  
or Acknowledgments of any Deed or Deeds, Feoffment  
or Conveyance by them that had right to grant  
bargain and sell any Mannors Lands Tenements  
or hereditaments within this Province have
