

Importers or Importers shall pay for the said liquors at the  
value thereof in ready money to the use of the Province  
as aforesaid

And be it further enacted by  
the authority aforesaid that when the Importers or Importors  
aforesaid have made fair entries aforesaid and paid the duties aforesaid  
that then the Naval Officer shall give the said Importer  
a permit to carry the same to any River Creek Harbour or  
any place of this province to make sale of the same

Provided always that if any person or persons shall  
bring any the Liquors aforesaid from Pennsylvania or in Sloop or  
other Vessels by Sea through the Capes of Chesapeake Bay  
into this province that then such Importer or Importors  
shall only pay the duty of three pence per Gallon as  
others do

And be it further enacted by the  
authority aforesaid and consent aforesaid that the Naval Officer  
aforesaid for the said duty of three pence per Gallon aforesaid shall  
with the public Treasurer of the Province and the  
public Treasurer of the Eastern Shore shall account to  
the Gen. Assembly of this province as is hereinafter  
mentioned which said Naval Officer shall make Oath  
before his Majesty the Governor or whom the Governor shall  
empower to administer such oath that the said Naval  
Officer shall use his utmost power and Diligence to  
cause this Act Effectually to be put in Execution and
