

such as shall have the next right to such Administration
 which said Administrator shall be duly qualified
 will warrant and give security as in the said Statute
 doe and shall sue and impeach the former Administrator
 before the Judge of the County for the exhibiting an Inventory
 and rendering an account of the Estate of the
 Intestate or if he shall refuse shall make applica-
 tion to such Judge of the County Genl for the assign-
 ment of the bond entered into by the former Administrator
 and his Sureties and shall or may put the same
 bond in suit against such Administrator and his
 Sureties if need be to be relieved thereon for any
 neglect or Male Administration by such former
 Administrator done or suffered of such deceased
 Estates

And be it further Enacted
 by the Authority aforesaid with the Advice and Consent
 of the whole Court that when a will is made by any Administrator
 of any Intestate Estate the Judge of the County shall make or
 cause to be made distribution of the surplusage of
 such Estate in the manner and form following that is
 to say, one third part of the said surplusage to the
 wife of the Intestate and all the residue by equal
 portions to and amongst the Children of such
 person dying Intestate and such persons as legally
 represent such Children in case any of the Children be
