

the increase of the small Estates they have without any
diminution of the principal which shall always be
delivered to the Officers at the year hereafter in the
same sum and appointed their such sum in man-
agement or other charitable person whereby obliged to
perform what is by this Act before required and to
be accounted by the County Court.

Provided always that where any person
being a protestant shall die and leave a widow
and children and such widow shall intermarry w.
any person of other Connexion or with herself
of that opinion and profession it shall and may be
lawfull for the Justices of the Peace and Sheriff within
his Province upon Application to him made to remove
such child or children out of the custody of such parents
and place them where they may be securely educated
in the protestant religion and to order such reasonable
Maintenance for such children as can be removed
out of the Estate or Estates belonging to such child or chil-
dren in whose hands ever having respect thereto only
the yearly profits and increase thereof being added thereto
so as such children may be well educated laboring
thereby and that all cattle horses and sheep shall
be retained in kind by the guardians or officers who
inherited with orphans Estates that is to say so many
cattle horses and sheep as were delivered to the guardians
