Be it Enacted by the King most Excellent
Majesty by and with the Advice and Consent of
that right Honourable the Lords of the Council
in Parliament assembled that no person shall
in any County, Town, or Village, or Hamlet, or
after such Auction made up Exhibited and past
in his Office or after distribution made by him, as yet
transmitt the Ballance or Airt thereof as before by
Writ is directed to the several and respective Justices
of the County Courts where the Plate shall be and re-
maine he or they shall first and pay to our Sovereign
Lord the King his heirs and Successors the sum of Ten
Thousand pounds of ^{the} of which one moiety for the
support of Government of this Province the other moiety
to him or them that shall sue for the same to be
recovered by action by action of Debt Bill Plaintiff
or Information wherein no Escoyne protection or
wager of Law to be allowed.

And whereas every Administrator in any
County Courts what debts are special and what
debts are despical the Judge for probate of wills shall
transmitt those despical debts of the State unto
the several and respective Justices of the County
Courts where the Plate shall lie to the said the said
Justices may inquire whether the said Administrator
shall by fraud or otherwise neglected to recover
the same or shall fraud and never accounted for the
