Brittanie or other sufficient willi of taton before
any Magistrate and a certificate thereof made
by any notary publick or Magistrate and sent
either under his hand and seal or any other so-
gall proff whatsoever made in this province or
elsewhere shall forfeit and pay the sum of five
hundred pounds of Tobs or fifty Shillings to the
party grieved to be recovered in any Court of Record
in this province agt such Master or his Heir
by Action of Debt or on the Case within seven
years after the date of the said bills of Reading
of such Tobs.

And be itt Enacted by the Authority
aforesaid that the Surety or Sureties of any Master of a
Ship or Vessel within this province shall be liable
to make Satisfaction according to this Act for the
Copping Cutting abusing Defacing and Impairing
of any bladders of Tobs as aforesaid and prosecuted for
the same in any Court of Record within this province
that can hold plea thereof and that every Justice
of Peace within this province shall on pain of
fifty Shillings Certificate under his hand and seal
who are the Surety or Sureties of any such Mas-
ter which shall be a sufficient evidence in any
Court of Record where such Action is commenced to
prove who are the Surety or Sureties of such Master
