Master for which Certificate the Naval Officers may
have and receive one Shilling and no more and
that the Gov. and respective Naval Officers within
this Province shall hang a fair Copy of this Law
in their respective Offices for the Renewal of all Masters
of Ships and Vessels the Naval Officer to have &
receive for the said Copy one hundred pounds of Tobacco
to be allowed in the Country Duty. And forasmuch
as by the Dilatation of Tobacco from the Calo-gango
of thirty Miles in the Diameter of the head to the pro-
vint-gango a larger quantity of Tobacco will be exported
in each hog-head whereby the Gov. Duties and Impost
on Tobacco by the Act will be evidently retrenched
and lessened unless a just regard be had to the
preservation of them in their usual work and value
which this gen. Assembly is highly obliged to those
Duties being generally applied to the support of Gov-
ernment and for other the most important affairs
of this Province and that therefore it is not only
just but necessary that the duty upon the hog-head
which shall be of this gango herein Directed should
be in some sort enlarged proportionably to the Enlarg-
ment of the said gango It is therefore most humbly
prayed that the Kings most Excellent Majesty will
be graciously pleased to grant that it may be
