VII. Be it likewise Enasten and Declared. That from and after the CHAP. End of this Session of Assembly, it shall not be lawful for any Attorney praction on the Province, to charge or take more than one Fee, for or upon one Attorney Bond or Bonds whatsoever, although there shall or may be one or more be charged on Surety or Sureties in such Bond or Bonds, for suing or bringing the same to any Bond Judgment and Execution, or for Desence of the same Action, rating such with Sureties. Fee or Fees from the real Balance due and owing upon the Sum mentioned be rated from the Condition of such Bond or Bonds.

VIII. And he it further Enacted, by the Authority aforefaid, That from and No more than after the End of this Session of Assembly, it shall not be lawful for any one Writ, County Clerk within this Province, to issue or make out, any more than One sued on such Writ or Declaration on such Bond or Bonds, wherein the Principal and Sure—Bonds, where ty or Sureties reside in one and the same County, but that in all such Cases, dants reside one Action only shall be founded on such Bond or Bonds; which Suit shall in the same not abate during the Life of any one of the Desendants; and the Clerks Fees county: arising thereon, shall be chargeable accordingly, and not otherwise.

IX. Provided always, That in all Actions hereafter to be commenced in But separate the Provincial Court on such Bond or Bonds, where the Principal and Surety Process may or Sureties therein reside in different Counties, in such Case separate Process they reside in shall and may issue thereon; but that where any Two of the Parties to such different Bond or Bonds reside in one and the same County, one Writ only shall issue Counties, &c. to such County, including both Desendants Names: therein, and all Fees arising thereon shall be chargeable as one Suit only, and not otherwise.

X. Provided always, That nothing herein contained shall extend, or be Proviso, with construed to extend, to any Action or Suit where the Plaintiff shall give Di-regard to the rections to any Attorney or Attorneys, to commence several Actions, or where Directions, a Titling or Titlings shall be sent to the said Office or Offices, for the suing of several Writs on one and the same Bond.

C H A P. XXIV.

An ACT repealing an Act of Assembly, entitled, * "An Act Passed 11th to enable the Rector, Vestry-men and Church-wardens, for July 1747. "the Time being, of St. Anne's Parish, in Anne-Arundel"

"County, to Lease certain Lots in the City of Annapolis, in "Manner, and to the Uses therein mentioned:" And to enable the said Rector, Vestry-men and Church-wardens, to Lease certain Lots of Land, within the said City of Annapolis. Lib. B.L.C. fol. 425.

HEREAS the Rector, Vestry-men and Church-wardens, of St. Preamble.

Anne's Parish, in Anne-Arundel County, have by their humble Petition to this General Assembly, set forth, That by an Act of Assembly, made and passed at a Session of Assembly begun and held at the City of Annapolis, on the Twenty-sirst Day of September Seventeen Hundred and Forty-two, entitled, An Ast to enable the Restor, Vestry-men and Church-wardens, for the Time being, of St. Anne's Parish, in Anne-Arundel County, to Lease certain Lots in the City of Annapolis, in Manner, and to the Uses therein mentioned, Power was given to Lease the Lots in the said City, Numbered respectively Fifty-nine, Sixty, Sixty-one, for Three Lives, or Twenty-one Years, as by the said Act may appear.
