And he it further Enacted, That every Person who shall kill or de-CHAP. stroy any Red Fox in any of the aforesaid Counties of Kent, Queen-Anne's, or Talbot, and shall bring the Head of the same to any Justice of the Peace Allowance for the aforesaid Counties, who is hereby required to burn, or otherwise de-Head of a stroy the same, and give the Person so bringing such Fox's Head, a Certifi-Red Fox: cate thereof, shall be allowed for every such Head, in the County Levy, the Quantity of Twenty Pounds of Tobacco.

IV.
