C H A P.

An ACT to annex certain extra-parochial Lands, lying between Passed 8th June 1751. Nassango Creek, and Accongo Branch, in Worcester County, to the Parish of All-Hallows. Lib. B.L.C. fol. 529.

THEREAS by the humble Petition of sundry Inhabitants of that Preamble, Part of a Place called the Indian-Town, in the County of Worcester, which lies between Nassango Creek, and Accongo Branch, it is represented to this General Assembly, That all that Tract or Parcel of Land lying and being in the Indian-Town aforesaid, between Nassango Creek, and Accongo Branch aforesaid, is not at present within the Bounds or Limits of any Parish; and that the Parish Church of All-Hallows, is the most convenient Place for the Inhabitants aforesaid to attend Divine Worship; and pray that the extra-parochial Lands aforesaid, may be annexed to the aforesaid Parish of All-Hallows: And this General Assembly having taken the Premises into Consideration, and thought the same Reasonable, it is humbly pray edthat it may be Enacted;

II. And be it Enacted, by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary, by and Certain exwith the Advice and Consent of his Lordship's Governor, and the Upper and Lower tra-parochial Houses of Assembly, and the Authority of the same, That all that Tract or Par-ed to du. cel of extra-parochial Land, fituate, lying and being, in the Place commonly Hadows Pacalled and known by the Name of the Table Towns of the Table called and known by the Name of the Indian-Town, between the Creek cal-cefter County. led Nassango Creek, and Accongo Branch, in Worcester County aforesaid, after the End of this present Session of Assembly, shall be, and it is hereby, annexed unto All-Hallows Parish in the County aforesaid. And it is also hereby Enatted, That all the Lands contained between the Limits aforesaid, shall, after the Time aforesaid, be deemed, reputed, adjudged and taken, as Part and Parcel of the said Parish of All-Hallows, and no other.

III. And be it further Enacted, by the Authority, Advice and Consent afore- And the Infaid, That the Inhabitants who now reside, or who may hereaster reside be-habitants to tween Nassango Creek, and Accongo Branch aforesaid, shall have and enjoy all vileges, &c. such Benefits, Privileges, Powers and Authorities, in every Respect, as other of other Pathe Inhabitants of the said Parish of All-Hallows now have, or hereafter may rishioners, have or enjoy; any Law, Usage or Custom to the contrary in any wise notwithstanding.
