

At a Session of ASSEMBLY begun and held at the City of *Annapolis*, on Wednesday the 17th Day of *March*, in the 11th Year of the Dominion of the Right Honourable FREDERICK, Lord Baron of *Baltimore*, absolute Lord and Proprietary of the Provinces of *Maryland* and *Avalon*, &c. and ended the 24th Day of *April* following, in the 12th Year of his Lordship's Dominion, *Annoq; Domini 1762*: The following Laws were Enacted.

An Act for the Adjournment and Continuance of Prince George's and Queen-Anne's County Courts. *Lib. H.S. fol. 398. OBS.* Passed 2<sup>d</sup> April 1762.

*Viz.* From the 4<sup>th</sup> Tuesday in *March* till the 4<sup>th</sup> Tuesday in *June* next.
