Cask or Case of Tobacco, put on board the same to be carried to any public Warehouse, at any other Place or Places than the Warehouse or Warehouses Tobacco reby this Act appointed for the Reception and Inspection of Tobacco, or at at Inspecting some or one of them, or the Wharfs or other Landing to such Warehouse Houses, &c. or Warehouses belonging; or shall put the same on board any other Vessel, or frauduor suffer the same to be done; so as the same be not delivered at some of the bezzelled, or faid public Warehouses, without Fraud or Embezzlement, or shall open any taken out of Hogshead, Cask or Case of Tobacco, so as aforesaid Water-born and Landed, Skipper, &c. and take thereout any Tobacco before the same be viewed by some Inspector before or after or Inspectors, according to the Directions of this Act; or, after the same Inspection, has been viewed, shall fraudulently open any Hogshead, Cask or Case, and to be adjudgtake thereout any Tobacco, every such Offence shall be adjudged Felony; ed Felony. and the Offender or Offenders shall suffer by Whipping and Pillorying, and paying Fourfold, as in Case of Felony.

VII. Provided always, That nothing herein before contained shall be Unless for construed to prohibit the Landing or putting on Shore, any Hogshead, Cask, necessary or Case of Tobacco out of any Sloop Book or other World Constitution or Case of Tobacco, out of any Sloop, Boat, or other Vessel, so as such Land- of the Toing be really and bona fide for the Preservation of the Tobacco laden in such bacco. Vessel, and that the same be with all convenient Speed, carried thereafter to the Warehouse or Ship (as the Case shall be) to which it was designed, without Embezzlement.

VIII. You shall Swear (or Affirm), That you will, diligently and carefully, view and The Oath of examine, all Tobacco brought to any public Warehouse, or Warehouses, where you an Inspector. are appointed to be Inspector, and all other Tobacco which you shall be called upon to view and inspect; and that you will not receive any Tobacco that is not, in your Judgment, sound, well-conditioned, merchantable, and clear of Trash; nor receive, pass, or stamp, any Tobacco, or Hogshead, Cask, or Case of Tobacco, probibited by an Act of Assembly, entitled, An Act for amending the Staple of Tobacco, for preventing Frauds in his Majesty's Customs, and for the Limitation of Officers Fees; and that you will receive, pass, and stamp, all Tobacco that is sound, well-conditioned, merchantable, and clear of Trash, and in all Things well and faithfully discharge your Duty in the Office of an Inspector, according to the best of your Skill and Judgment, and according to the Directions of the said Aci, without Fear, Favour, Affection, Malice, or Partiality.
