**FINES, &c.**—Support of Government. wherein is an Incumbent, forfeit 5000<sup>lb</sup> Tobacco. See *Marriage*, 1, 2.

County Courts neglecting to appoint Preſs-maſters, forfeit, each Juſtice, 500<sup>lb</sup> Tobacco: And Perſons ſo appointed, refuſing to ſerve, &c. forfeit 500<sup>lb</sup> Tobacco for each Offence. See *Preſs-maſters*, 2, 3.

Perſons unlawfully abuſing their Servants, forfeit, for the Firſt and Second Offence, a Sum not exceeding 1000<sup>lb</sup> Tobacco. See *Servants*, 12.

Fines for Breach of Rules in the Provincial Court are not to exceed 1000<sup>lb</sup> Tobacco. See *Provincial Court*, 2.

4. **FINES**, where Half is given to his Lordſhip, Half to the Informer.

Maſters not delivering a Gun to a Man-Servant at the Expiration of his Servitude, &c. And ſuch Freeman ſelling the ſame within Twelve Months, forfeit 500<sup>lb</sup> Tobacco. See *Freedom Dues*, 1.

Perſons Running Tobacco out of the Province, without Entry with the proper Officer, forfeit 10<sup>l</sup>. Sterling per Hoghead, or other Package, and the like Penalty for every Parcel of 500 Weight, and ſo in Proportion. See *Tobacco Run*, 1.

Tobacco, put on board any Boat, &c. in any River or Creek, from whence Tobacco hath been uſually carried into any neighbouring Colonies, or laden in any Cart, &c. without a Permit from the proper Officer, ſhall be forfeited, with the Veſſel, Cart and Horſes, &c. See *Ibid.* 2.

Perſons abuſing or reſiſting Officers in the Execution of this Law, forfeit 10<sup>l</sup>. Sterling. See *Ibid.* 3.

Officers of the Customs, Magiſtrates, Sheriffs, Veſtry-men, Church-wardens and Conſtables, neglecting to put this Act in Execution, forfeit 5<sup>l</sup>. Sterling for every Neglect. See *Ibid.* 4.

Perſons convict of Thieving, &c. hunting or carrying a Gun on any ſeated Plantation, without Leave, &c. forfeit 1000<sup>l</sup>. Tobacco. See *Hog Stealing*, 3.

5. **FINES**, where Half is given to Support of Government, and Half to the Informer, &c.

Injuring of Harbours by throwing out Ballaſt, Penalty is 50<sup>l</sup>. Currency: By building of Wears, &c. Penalty is 10<sup>l</sup>. Currency. See *Harbours*, 1, 2.

Naval Officers neglecting to keep a Copy of the Act for preventing the Injury of Harbours in their Offices, forfeit 10<sup>l</sup>. Currency. See *Naval Officers*, 7.

Shipping, or transporting Hides tanned or untanned, or old Iron, out of the Province, the Penalty is 50<sup>l</sup>. Currency. See *Hides*, 2.

The Fines upon Ingroſſers. See *Ingroſſers*, 2.

Carrying Liquors to Indian Towns; Penalty, 5000<sup>lb</sup> Tobacco. See *Indians*, 1.

Clerk of the Council, and Clerk of the Lower Houſe, neglecting to tranſmit Copies of the reſpective Journals of the Two Houſes to the Secretary's Office, within Two Months after the End of each Seſſion, forfeit 500<sup>lb</sup> Tobacco. See *Journals of Aſſembly*.

Perſons Marrying without Publication or Licence, forfeit 5000<sup>lb</sup> Tobacco: And Miniſters marrying ſuch, forfeit 5000<sup>lb</sup> Tobacco. See *Marriage*, 6—8.

Perſons reſident in this Province, getting their Marriage ſolemnized in any neighbouring Colony (unleſs the Woman be Reſident in ſuch Colony) forfeit 5000<sup>lb</sup> Tobacco. See *Ibid.* 9.

Perſons exacting more than legal Intereſt, forfeit treble Value of the Debt. See *Uſury*, 3.

Millers taking unlawful Toll, forfeit 1000<sup>lb</sup> Tobacco. See *Water Mills*, 5.

Collectors not ſetting up Tables of their Fees, in their Offices, forfeit 50<sup>l</sup>. Sterling. See *Collectors*.

County Courts neglecting to give in Charge to the Orphan Jury, every June Court, to enquire if any Waſte hath been made of Orphans Lands, forfeit 1600<sup>lb</sup> Tobacco. See *Orphans*, 14.

**FINES.**—Half to the Support of Government, &c.

Perſons permitting or conniving at Running Tobacco, before Duty paid, into *Pennſylvania*, &c. and the Owners, Purchaſers and Carriers of ſuch Tobacco, and their Aſſiſtants and Abettors, forfeit 10<sup>l</sup>. Sterling for every Hoghead, or every 400<sup>lb</sup> Tobacco ſo carried. See *Tobacco Duties*, 2.

Veſtries neglecting to tranſmit a yearly Account (of the diſpoſal of the 40 per Poll during the Vacancy of any Pariſh, or of the 10 per Poll Parochial Tax) to the Governor and Council, forfeit 1000<sup>lb</sup> Tobacco. See *Veſtry*, 29.

Secretary making default in Recording the Acts of Aſſembly, forfeits 10,000<sup>lb</sup> Tobacco. See *Acts of Aſſembly*, 5.

Magiſtrates, Sheriffs, or Clerks, practiſing as Attorneys in the Courts wherein they bear Office, forfeit 3000<sup>lb</sup> Tobacco. See *Attorneys*, 1.

Attorney-General, &c. iſſuing Criminal Proceſs without Preſentment, &c. forfeits in the Provincial Court 5000<sup>lb</sup> Tobacco, in a County Court 2500<sup>lb</sup> Tobacco. See *Ibid.* 4.

Sheriffs taking Bail Bonds for more than 8000<sup>lb</sup> Tobacco in Action of Treſpaſs, forfeit 4000<sup>lb</sup> Tobacco. See *Bail Bonds*.

Commiſſary-General neglecting to tranſmit Accounts of the Balances of Inteſtates Eſtates to the County Court, &c. forfeits 10,000<sup>lb</sup> Tobacco. See *Commiſſary-General*, 4.

Sheriffs not giving due Notice, &c. of Elections, may be fined at the Diſcretion of the Lower Houſe of Aſſembly, not exceeding 250<sup>l</sup>. Sterling. See *Delegates*, 4.

Deputy-Commiſſary not tranſmitting Accounts in Time, to the Commiſſary-General, forfeits 2000<sup>lb</sup> Tobacco. See *Deputy-Commiſſary*, 5.

County Clerks iſſuing Criminal Proceſs without an Order for the ſame, under the Hand of an Attorney, forfeit 2500<sup>lb</sup> Tobacco. See *County Clerks*, 21.

County Clerks delivering out blank Writs, &c. forfeit 6000<sup>lb</sup> Tobacco. See *Ibid.* 22.

Merchants or Others, Shipping Tobacco before Publication of the Freight, forfeit all ſuch Tobacco, or the Value thereof. Maſters of Ships taking Tobacco on board before ſuch Publication, forfeit 20<sup>s</sup>. per Hoghead. Omitting to ſend Certificate of ſuch Publication with Craft fetching Tobacco from another County, forfeit 20<sup>s</sup>. Sterling. And Collectors and Naval Officers neglecting to affix Copies of this Act in their reſpective Offices, forfeit 40<sup>s</sup>. Sterling. See *Freight of Tobacco*.

Sheriffs neglecting to forward Public Letters, forfeit 2000<sup>lb</sup> Tobacco. See *Letters Public*, 4.

Perſons breaking open any Public Letter, forfeit 20<sup>l</sup>. Sterling. See *Ibid.* 5.

Perſons breaking open any Private Letter, forfeit 5<sup>l</sup>. Sterling. See *Letters Private*, 1.

County Clerks neglecting to tranſmit a Copy of the Levy to the Governor and Council yearly, before the Tenth of March, forfeit 1000<sup>lb</sup> Tobacco. See *Levies*, 2.

Liquors brought by Land from *Pennſylvania* to any other Place than *Bohemia* Landing, or put on board any Veſſel in the Bay, before Duty paid, are forfeited, or their Value. See *Liquors Imported*, 9, 11.

Liquors landed before Invoice upon Oath, and Entry made, are forfeited, or the Value. See *Ibid.* 14, 15.

Perſons exacting undue Fees upon Naturalization Bills, forfeit 2000<sup>lb</sup> Tobacco. See *Naturalization Bills*, 2.

Naval Officers neglecting to put up Tables of their Fees in their ſeveral Offices, forfeit 50<sup>l</sup>. Sterling. See *Naval Officers*, 6.

Naval Officers not ſetting up a Copy of the Act to prevent Injury of Harbours in their Offices, forfeit 10<sup>l</sup>. Currency. See *Ibid.* 7.
