E it Enacted by the King and Queens most Excellent Majesties, by and with the Advice and Consent of this present General Assembly, and the Authority of the same, That from and after the publication hereof, the Land called the Town Land at Severn in Ann-Arundel County, where the Town was formerly, and the Land at Oxford, in Talbot County, where the Lands. Town was formerly, shall from henceforth be Towns and Ports and places of Trade, where all Ships and Vessels may come to for Entring and Clearing; to which End the Collector of that District, or his lawfull ty shall reside. Deputys, shall constantly reside at the said Towns and Ports; and also a Naval Officer or Officers or their Deputys shall also constantly reside there, val Officer or his or giving Dispatch to all Ships and Vessels Coming or Trading into them Parts. And that the same Towns and Ports may be capable of being Built upon and inhabited by Persons desiring to dwell and inhabit in

Be it Enacted by the Authority aforefaid, That from and after the Promissioners, shall be Commissioners of and for the said two Towns, and the Power of ach of them.
