Bar to the owners and Persons Interested in the said Lands, either within or without this Province, even against his Lordships the Right Honourable Charles Lord Baron of Baltemore, Lord Proprietary of this Province, his Heirs and Successors, yielding and paying to the said Lord Proprie-Paying Quit Rents, tary and his Successors sorever the yearly Rent of one Penny, current Money, for each respective Lot, as asoresaid, and that the Surveyor of surveyors sees as each Town and Port as asoresaid, shall have and receive such Fees and certained. Rewards for laying and Staking the Towns and Lots as asoresaid, as the said Commissioners shall allow and Settle, and no more, and any Person or Persons that shall build and inhabit in such Port or Town Ten per cent allowed shall owe any Sum or Sums of Tobacco and will pay the same in lowed on Tobacco and shall owe as he shall be allowed Ten town for every Househead of fuch Town as he shall be allowed Ten per Cent, for every Hogshead of our hundred Weight and upwards, to paid in Towns to be deducted out of the Debt aforesaid, or pleadable in Bar, of the Creditors.

And be it Enacted, by the Authority afore aid, by and with the Advice and Consent aforesaid, That any Person or Persons that have heretofore The Estates of taken up any Lot or Lots, in either of the Towns by Virtue of any for Lots formerly taken ther Law of this Province and built thereon according to the same former up Law, they and every of them their Heirs and Assignes thall have and enjoy good and Sure Estate of Inheritance to them and their heirs sorever, under the Rents and Services herein mentioned, and the several Lots so built on shall be deemed and taken as part of the one hundred Lots as aforesaid, and the same Town laid out as conveniently there to as may be.

And be it Enacted, by the Authority aforesaid, That at the Town and Port of Severn in Ann-Arundal County, shall be bought or valued By the Jury, as before in this Act is mentioned; All that Percel or Neck At Seavern than of Land, within Levey-Neck Cove and Acton's Cove, lying and adjoyning be bought a publick in near to the Town Land as aforesaid, or so much thereof as by the Commissioners shall be found convenient to be Fenced in, and called the sown Common or Pasture, and paid for and Fenced in at the Publick Charge, and shall be for the Publick Use and Service when need shall Towns People not require, and that the Inhabitants of the taid Towns shall not raise any to raise Stocks Stock of Cattle or Hoggs, Horses or Sheep, more than what they can contain and raise upon their respective Lot or Lots, and not more, at the Discretion of the Commissioners of the said Towns.
