Provided always, That it shall and may be lawful for any person or in case of desertipersons that hath formerly taken up and obtained any Grants from the on the owner may Lord Baltemore for any Tracts or Parcels of Land within the aforesaid occupy. And be it turther Enacted by the Authority aforesaid, That it shall not nor may be lawfull for the said Lord Baltemore to ask, have or demand payable till owners enjoy it. any Rent or Service for any of the said Tracts or Dividends, as may or have been taken up as aforesaid, within the said Indian Boundaries, until such Time that the Takers up or owners aforesaid, do enjoy or posses the same, any Law, Usage or Custom to the contrary notwith-

Standing:

An Act requiring the Masters of Ships and Vessels to publish the Rates of their Freight before they take any Tobacco on Board.

E it Enalted by the Queens most Excellent Majesty, by and with the Advice and Confent of Her Majesty's Governour, Council and Assembly of this Province, and the Authority of the same, That every Master and Commander of a Ship or Other Vessel, that purposes to export Tobacco on Freight, shall before he take any such Tobacco on Board his said Ship or Vessel, publish in Writing, by a Note under his Hand, Freight to be pub. which he shall cause to be affixed on the Court-House Door of that listed and how. County where his faid Ship shall ride at Anchor, at what Rate he will eceive Tobacco upon Freight per Ton, on Board his said Ship, for that ntended Voyage, which Note the Clerk of the County shall enter upon Record.

And be it further Enacted by the Authority oforesaid, That whatsoever Merchant or other Inhabitants of this Province shall put any Tobacco on Board any Ship, Sloop or Boat belonging to a Ship, on Freight, Penalty on Freight before such Master of such Ship, hath set up such Note, as aforesaid, he shall forseit and loose all such Tobacco, so shipped on Board such before such Master of such Ship, hath set up such Note, as aforesaid, um. Ship, Sloop or Boat, or the full Vallue thereof, in Money, whereof one Ship, Sloop or Boat, or the full Vallue thereof, in Money, whereof one half to her Majesty for the support of the Government of this Province, the other half to him or them that will sue for the same, to be recovered in any Court of Record in this Province by Action of Debr, Bill, Plaint or Information, wherein no Essoyn, Protection or Wager of Law to be allowed.
