brogating or suspending the Force, Vigour or Effect of the aforesaid Act
For preventing the growth of Popery, in any other matter or thing what-
soever, or for or during any longer time than what is herein exprest and
declared.

An Act explaining some doubtful Expressions in the Act for
Limitation of Officers Fees.

WHereas in the said Act for *Limitation of Officers Fees*, it is ex-
prest, The Secretary shall have for every Execution and Return
and a Blank left for the Sum, when it ought to have
been exprest 28 Pounds of Tobacco.

Be it Enacted by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the Ad-
vice and Consent of her Majesty's Governour, Council and Assembly of this
Province, and the Authority of the same, That he shall have for an Ex-
ecution and Return 28 Pounds of Tobacco. and for any matter entred
upon Record, not exceeding half a side, 8 l. of Tobacco, and for every con-
tinuance in Chancery, 16 l. of Tobacco.

Secretary's Fees.

And be it Enacted, That such Fees in the several Cases aforesaid as
were appointed by his Excellency the Governour in Council to be paid
to the Secretary until this Present Session of Assembly, shall be satisfied
and paid to the Secretary by the Persons from whom the same are
due, and on Non-payment thereof, it shall be lawful to levy the
same by way of Execution. This Act to endure so long as the said
Act for *Limitation of Officers Fees* shall be in Force and no longer.

On Execution.

Duration.

An Act Requiring the Agents of the Lord *Baltimore* to cer-
tify into the Secretary's Office the Instructions and Condi-
tions of Plantations, with the Fees by them demanded, and
obliging his Lordships Deputy Surveyors to qualifie them-
selves according to Law.

BE it Enacted by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the Ad-
vice and Consent of her Majesty's Governour, Council, and Assembly of
this Province, and the Authority of the same, That the Lord *Baltimore's*
Agents for granting Lands in this Province, on or before the fourteenth
Day of May next, shall make, certifie and hang up in the Secretary's
Office all such Instructions that the said Officer or Agents of the said
Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary of this Province have from his
Lordship, that concern the People of this Province, and all the Condi-
tion or Conditions of Plantations, that all People may see and know by
what Authority they Act.

Instructions and
Conditions to be
Certified.

And that they likewise prepare a List of what Fees they require for
several Services by them done, or to be done, which Fees shall be con-
sidered of by two of her Majesty's Council, and by two or more Justices
of the Provincial Court, which Fees the said Councillors and
Justices may lessen as they see fit, and be allowed under the Hands of
such Councillors and Justices, or else it shall not be lawful for such
his Lordships Officers, Ministers, Agents or Clerks to demand or receive
them; but when such Fees shall be allowed and approved on, as afore-
said

Their Fees to
