An Act for the Publication of all the Laws of this Province, and for the Recording the same in the Secretary's Office, as also for transmitting the Journals of the Council in Assembly, and of the House of Delegates into the said Office, to the End that no Person may be Ignorant of the Laws in this Province.

BE it Enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the Adof this Province and the Authority of the Jame, That from hence forward scribed on Parchall the Acts that shall pass from this and all the succeeding Assemblies ment and publish-Thall be, from time to time fairly transcribed on Parchment, and for theriff. want thereof, on good Paper with a parchment Cover, and by Writ under the Great Seal of this Province, from time to time, by the Keeper of the Seal, for the Time being, to the Sheriff of each Respective County, shall be transmitted, and Commandment to them, in the said Writs shall be given, The said Acts in their several and respective Counties, at their next County-Court, to publish, and Proclaim sirmly to be observed and kept, and Lodged with the Clerk of each respective Court for the Use thereof.

And be it further Enacted by Authority aforesaid, That every several Transcripts of and respective County, shall, from time to time, pay to the Chan-Laws to be paid for cellour, for the time being, for such Transcript of the Laws, so much To what the Assembbacco as by the said General Assembly in which the said Laws are made, by shall assess.
