An Act for stay of Execution after the Tenth of May yearly.

THEREAS many of the Inhabitants of this Province are and have been exceedingly grieved and burthened by Executions laid upon them in the Summer Time, when it is not possible for them to procure Effects for the Payment and Satisfiction of their Creditors, by means whereof they are often times kept in Prison a long time, and
