And be it further Enacted by the Authority aforesaid, That it any Mat- All other Matters ter of Dispute arises concerning Servants Imported into this Province, to be so determinor any Servant that binds himself for Years within this Province, or any Bound out by the County Courts of this Province, in relation to their Indentures, Contract or Wages, or any other Matter of Difference. between the said Master and Servant, the same shall be tryed, heard and determined by Petition, as aforesaid, any Law, Statute or Usage to the contrary notwithstanding.

And be it Enacted by the Authority, Advice and Consent aforesaid, That no Negro or other Slave within this Province, shall be permitted to slaves not to carry carry any Gun, or any other offensive Weapon from of their Masters Guns, dre-Land, without License from their said Master; and if any Negro or other Slave shall presume so to do, he shall be lyable to be carried before a Justice of Peace, and be Whipt, and his Gun or other Offensive Weapon shall be forseited to him that shall seize the same, and carry fuch Negro so Offending, before a Justice of Peace.

And be it Enacted by the Authority aforesaid, by and with the Advice and Consent aforesaid, That from and after the End of this Sessions of Assembly, any Servant or Servants whatsoever, within this Province, Servants stealing their Masters that shall feloniously take or purloin his or their Master, Mistress or Goods.
