And be it further Enacted by the Authority aforesaid, by and with the Advice and Consent aforesaid, That all Persons whether Inhabitants or Foreigners, shall repair and bring their Stilliards with which they and Measures to be weigh and receive their Tobacco, to the Standard, Yearly and every tryed and stamp c. Year, to be tryed, Stampt and Numbered, for which they are to pay the Person keeping the Standard, One Shilling for every Time such Stilliards and payed for. Ih Il betryed and stampt, as aforesaid. And every Person or Persons shall have their Bushel, Haif-Bushel, Peck, Gallon, Pottle, Quart and Pint, if they make use of the same, or any of them, in buying or selling, duly tryed and stampt at the Standard aforesaid, except such of Measures aforesaid, as come out of England, and are there Stamped; for which trying and stamping, they shall pay Six Pence apiece.

And whosoever shall presume to sell by any Dry Measures, without Tobicco for Dry first having the said Measures Tryed and stampt at the Standard, shall Measure,

forfeit the Sum of Five Hundred Pounds of Tobacco.

And whosoever likewise shall presume to weigh and receive Tobacco and 1000 l. Tob. by stilliards, which have not within one year past, from such weighing and receiving, been tryed and stampt at the standard, shall forfeit One Thousand Pounds of Tobacco, the one half of which aforementioned Forfeitures to be paid to his Majesty, his Heirs and Successors, towards the defraying the Charge of the County, where the offender shall dwell or reside, and the other half to the Informer or Informers, to be recovered in any County-Court of this Province, by Bill, Plaint or Information, wherein no Effoyn, Protection or Wager of Law to be allowed.

And if any Person or Persons shall refuse to pay any Tobacco by such who shall pay for Stilliards tryed and stamped, as aforesaid, and shall thereby compel the stamping stuliards Owner to have them tryed over again within the year, if the Stilliards are true, such Person so refusing or Compelling, as aforesaid, shall pay for the new stamping, but if not, the Owners of the Stilliards to pay for

the same.

An Act against Embezlement of Wills or Records within this Province.

Orasmuch as there is not any sufficient Remedy provided against such as shall Imbez!e, alter or raze any Records of Deeds for Conveying of Land within this Province, or any Will or Records of Wills, or. the other Deeds or Instruments that shall any ways touch or concern the Estate of Inheritance or Free-hold of any Person whatsoever; And for that it is found Necessary to make some provision against such Evil Practices,

Be it therefore Enasted by the King's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the Advice and Consent of his Mujesty's Governour, Council and Assembly of this Province, and the Authority of the same, That in case any Person whatloever shall at any time hereafter be legally convicted, by Confession, or otherwise, of wilfully or Corruply Imbezling, Impairing Razing or altering any Will or Record within this Province, whereby the Estate of Inheritance or Free-hold of any Person whatsoever, shall be deseated, injured or any way's altered, such Person so Convict shall forfeit all his Goods and Chattles, Lands and Tenements, the one half to our Sovereign Lord the King, his Heirs and Successors, for the support of Government, the K k 3
