Authorized and impowered to award and cause to be Inflicted according to the nature of the Crime, such Punishment by Whipping, as he shall think fit, not exceeding Forty Lashes.

An Act for quieting Differences that may arise between the Inhabitants of this Province, and the Several Nations of Indians, of what Places soever.

Hereas many differences have and may hereaster arise and grow between the English and Indians, which for want of a speedy way of determining the tame, many great Charges and Inconveniences have and may happen thereupon by the said Controversies being brought from the remotest Parts of this Province, to be heard and determined before the Governour and Council, to the very great trouble of the Persons concerned, and the publick Charge which to prevent, and to give a speedy redress in all such Matters,

Be it Enacted by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary, by and may Determine with the Advice and Consent of his Lordship's Governour, and the Upper and Private Differen-Lower Houses of Assembly, and the Authority of the same, That from ces, and after the end of this Present Session of Assembly, any Justice of the

Provincial or County-Courts within this Province, be, and are hereby authorized and impowered to hear and determine all manner of Conhoversies and Differences whatsoever, that shall or may hereaster hap-

pen or grow between the English and Indians in private and personal lings value. Controverlies, not exceeding the value of Twenty Shillings Sterling.

And be it further Enacted by the Authority aforesaid, That any of the Justices aforesaid be and are hereby authorized and impowered upon hearing and determining any fuch Difference or Controversie, as aforesaid, And Award Exand Judgment thereupon given, either party refuling to perform the ecution by diffress ame, then and in every such Cale the Justice so impowered, as afore-of Goods, hid, shall by way of Distress take into his Custody any of the Goods and Chattels of the Offender, and out of the same make full Satisaction to the party wronged, at the Discretion of the said Justice, and the Over-plus to return to the Owner thereof.

An Act for laying an Additional duty of Twenty Shillings Current Money per Poll on all Irish Servants, being Papists, to prevent the growth of Popery by the Importation of too great a Number of them into this Province; and also, the Additional Duty of Twenty Shillings Current Money per Poll on all Negroes, for raising a Fond for the Use of Publick-Schools within the several Counties of this Province.
