

Me 39. An Act confirming and explaining the Charter to the City of Annapolis.

HEREAS this present General Assembly have taken into their Confideration the Charter lately granted to the City of Annapolis, and being desirous to give all due Encouragement to Cohabitation, have resolved to confirm the same Charter, and to explain and restrain some Clauses and Grants therein contained, they humbly pray that it may be Enacted; and it is hereby Enacted by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the Advice and Consent of Her Majesty's Governor, Council, and Assembly of this Province, and the Authority of the same, That the said Charter to the City of Annapolis, bearing Date at the said City the Twenty second Day of November, Anno One thousand seven hundred and eight, in the Seventh Year of Her Majesty's Reign, sealed with the Great Scal of this Her Majesty's Province, and signed with the Sign Manual of His Excellency John Seymour Esq; Captain General and Governor in Chief thereof, Incorporating the Inhabitants of Annapolis into a City and Body Corporate; and the several Articles, Clauses, Grants, Powers, Authorities, and Privileges, therein contained, shall, by Virtue of this Act, be
