That Newport Hundred shall be united to William and Mary

Majesty's Governour, Council and Assembly of this Province, and the Authority of the same, That from and after the First Day of June next ensuing after the End of this present Session of Assembly, the said Hundred of Newport shall be divided and taken from the said Parish called King and Queen's Parish in St. Mary's County, and be added and united unto William and Mary Parish in Charles County, in which the same lies, and shall, from and after the Time aforesaid, by vertue of this Act, be deemed, adjudged, reputed and taken as Part and Parcel of the said William and Mary Parish, and not as Part or Parcel of King and Queen's Parish in St. Mary's County; and that the Inhabitants thereof shall have and enjoy all Benefits and Privileges equal with any other the Inhabitants of the said Parish, any Law, Statute, Usage or Custom to the contrary notwithstanding.

And the Inhabitants thereof to enjoy equal Privileges with the Inhabitants of the said Parisb.

An Act for Erecting a Parish on the North Side of Elk Laws of Me River in Cecil County.

Desimuch as it hath been represented to this present General

Assembly, That by the ill Situation of the Parish Church in

Preamble.

Cecil County, being built on the South Side of Elk River, within the said County, the Inhabitants on the North Side of the said River cannot come to that Church, and are thereby deprived of the great Blessing of having the Gospel preached among them: for Remedy whereof it is prayed, that it may be Enacted, and be it Enacted by the Queen's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the Advice and Consent of her Majesty's Governour, Council and Assembly of this Province, and the Authority of the same, That from and after the First Day of May, One Thousand Seven Hundred and Six, all that Part of Cecil County lying on the North the North Side of Elk Side of Elk River, being bounded as followeth, (that is to say,) River, be a diffinit beginning at Turkey Point on the North Side of Elk River aforesaid, and running with the said River to Smith's Mill at the Head thereof, then East to the exterior Bounds of this Province, and with the exterior Bounds of this Province to Susquehana River, The Bounds of the thence with the East Side of the said River, and Bay of Chesepeak,

to the first beginning, shall be, and is by this Act constituted,
