re execute the same Office, and also shall render unto his said Majesty and other his Officers, a true, faithful and perfect Account of all and fingu-" lar his faid Majesty's Righrs and Dues and to his Officers a true and " just Account of their Fees, that he shall or may be entrusted with by " his faid Majesty's Governour, and other his Officers within this Prowince to receive and collect; and his Account to his faid Majesty, his " Heirs and Successors, and to his and their Governour here, for the "Time being, for the Fines and Forfeitures, and other Dues belonging " to his said Majesty's Governour; as also his Account of all Fees, " Dues and Sums of Money or Tobacco due to any of the good Peo-" ple within this Province, for any Sum or Sums of Money or To-" bacco, wherewith the faid Sheriff shall be entrusted, during the Time " of his Shrievalry for this prefent, or to luch of them as shall require " the fame, shall pass and render by the Tenth Day of May, next en-" suing the Date hereof; and in all other Things as Sheriff of the County shall behave himself well and honestly to all Persons, ac-" cording to the best of his Power, Skill and Knowledge: Then " this Obligation to be void and of none Effect, or else to stand in full Force, Strength and Virtue.

Which said Bond taken in Form 2 oresaid, if by the County-Court, To be transthe Commissioners thereof shall Yearly transmit the same unto the Se-mitted to the cretary's Office within Two Months a ter the taking thereof; in Default Office in two where of the Commissioners of any County-Court taking such Bond, Months by and not causing the same to be so transmitted within the Time afore- the Justices, faid, shall forfeit to his Majesty his Heirs and Successors Fifteen Hundred 15001. Tob. Pounds of Tobacco, the one Half whereo shall be applied to the Support of Government, and the other to the Informer, or such Person that will sue for the same; to be recovered in the Provincial Court of this Province, wherein no Essoyn, Protection or Wager of Law shall be allowed.

And the said Secretary and his chief Clerk of the Provincial Court shall be obliged at the next Council after receiving any Sheriff's Bond hid before or Bonds into the Secretary's Office, to lay the same before his Excellency and Council the Governour of this Province, for the Time being, for his Approba- for Approbation or Difallowance of the Securities taken by the County-Courts. And the faid Commissioners are hereby required and enjoyned to take . new Security Yearly, and every Year, of fuch Sheriffs, so long as they shall continue in the said Office, and transmit the same as aforesaid; hav- New Securiing a special Regard not to admit any Person to be Security, as a ore-ty yearly, and said, but such as are good and substantial Free-holders within their how. Counties; and also to make the Obligation of such Bond, so to be taken from any Sheriff, answerable to the Publick Charge of their respective Counties, which Penalty shall not be less than Two Hundred Thousand Pounds of Tobacco as aforefuid.

And for the Encouragement of such Persons now bearing, or that shall hereafter bear the Office of Sheriff, and who shall punctually comply be continued with the publick Creditor, It is also hereby further Enacted, by the Autho- 3 Years, rity, Advice and Consent aforesaid, That'it shall and may be lawful for his Majesty's Governour, for the Time being, where no just Complaint is made against such Sheriff, to continue and make good their Commission for the Time and Term of Three Years successively, but no longer.
