At a Seflions of Aflembly, begun and held at the

City of *Annapolis*, the Fifth Day of *April*, in the Fifth Year of the Dominion of *CHARLES* Lord Baron of *Baltimore*, absolute Lord and Proprietary of the Provinces of *Maryland* and *Avalon*, &c. *Annoq; Domini*, One Thousand Seven Hundred and Twenty, the following Laws were Enacted.

An ACT reviving and continuing the ACT entituled,

An Act afcertaining the Gauge and Tare of Tobacco-Hogsheads, &c. from the Twenty Ninth Day of September next, until the Twenty Ninth Day of September which fhall be in the Year of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred and Twenty One.

FORASMUCH as an Act made at a Seflions of Aflembly; begun and held at the City of *Annapolis*, in *Ann-arundel* County, the Seventeenth Day of *July*, in the firft Year of the Dominion of the Right Honourable *Charles*, absolute Lord and Proprietary of the Provinces of *Maryland* and *Avalon*, Lord Baron of *Baltimore*, &c. *Annoq; Domini* One Thousand Seven Hundred and Sixteen, entituled, *An Act afcertaining the Gauge and Tare of Tobacco-Hogsheads, and to prevent cropping, cutting and defacing Tobacco, taken on Board Ships, or other Veffels, upon Freight, and for laying an Imposition on Tobacco per the Hoghead, for the Support of Government, and for the Encouraging Settlements in this Province, by afcertaining the Manner of paying his Lordship's Alienation Fines and Quit-Rents, for the Term therein propofed, and for taking off the Three Pence per Hoghead, formerly raifed for the publick Charge,* expires the Twenty Ninth Day of *September* next; and for preventing any Inconveniency that might happen either to his Lordship, or the Inhabitants of this Province, if the aforementioned Act fhould expire before a further Provision could be made for its Continuance; it is therefore prayed it may be Enacted,

To prevent Inconveniencies by the Expiration of this Act,

And be it Enacted by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary, by and with the Advice and Consent of his Lordship's Governour, and the Upper and Lower Houfes of Aflembly, and by the Authority of the fame, That the abovementioned Act, entituled, An Act for afcertaining the Gauge and Tare of Tobacco-Hogsheads, &c. is hereby revived and continued, to be and remain in full Force from the Twenty Ninth Day of September next, until the Twenty Ninth Day of September, which fhall be in the Year of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred and Twenty One.

The Act is revived, and continu'd in Force.
