E it Enacted by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary, by and with the Advice and Conjent of His Loraship's Governour, and the Upper and Lower Houses of Assembly, and the Authority of the same, That an A& made at a Sessions of Assembly begun and held at the City of Annapolis the Eleventh Day of October last, entituled, An Act for raising a Duty of Three Pence per Horsbead on all Tobacco exported out of this Province, for the Uses therein mentioned; be and is hereby revived and continued to be and remain in full Force, from the Twenty Ninth Day of September next, until the Twenty Ninth Day of September that shall happen in the Year of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred and Twenty Thrce.

E it Enacted by the Right Honourable the Lord Proprietary, by and with the Advice and Consent of His Lordship's Governour, and the Upper and Lower Houses of Assembly, and the Authority of the Jame, That the above-mention'd Act entituled, An Act for relieving the Inhabitants of this Province from some Aggrievances in the Prosecutions of Suits at Law, made at a Sessions of Assembly begun and held at the City of Annapolis the Twenty Second Day of June, Anno Dom' One Thousand Seven Hundred and Fourteen; be and is hereby revived All continued and continued in full Force, from and after the End of this present Sessions of Aslembly, until the Twenty Ninth Day of September that shall happen in the Year of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred and Twenty Three.
