At a Sessions of Assembly, begun and held at the City of Annapolis, the Sixth Day of October, Anno Domini One Thousand Seven Hundred and Twenty Four, the following Laws were Enacted, viz.

A Supplementary ACT to the Act, Entituled, An Act for the Relief of Debtors; and ascertaining the Manner of Tenders in Tobacco.

ORASMUCH as the Time limited by the faid Act for tendering Tobacco, is so short, that honest Debtors intended to be relieved thereby, have not the Benefit that was intended them by the Assembly: And for that many of the Inhabitants of this Province have complained that several Sherits's have resused good merchantable Tobacco tor Publick and other Dues, and Officers Fees. with Intent to extort great Prices in Money from the Debtors, or make some other unjust Profit to themselves:

Be it therefore Enacted, by the Right H nourable the Lord Proprietor. by and with the Advice and Consent of His I ordship's G vernour, and the Upper and Lower Houses of Assembly, and the Authority of the sime, That all Tobaco made Debtors tendering Tobacco at any Time between the first Day of November, and the last Day of May Yearly, thall have the same Priviledges, Benefits and Advantages as they might have had by Virtue of the said recited Act, in case of Tenders between the first Day of November, and the last of March Yearly; any Limitation therein contained to the

contrary notwithstanding.

Provided always, That the Creditor shall not be obliged to receive Tobacco of less Weights, or worse Quality, than the Debtor hath contracted to pay; any thing in this Act, or the said recited Act to the contrary notwithstanding.

And be it Enacted, That Tobacco to be paid to the Sheriff, in Disbe paid to the charge of Publick and other Dues and Fees, shall and may be viewed and examined as the faid recited A& directs Tobacco to discharge must be view- other Debts to be viewed and examined; and that where any Person hath good merchantable Tobacco in Hogsheads, (or in Parcels, if the Debt be but a Parcel) ready to pay the Sheriff, and tenders the same, and that notwithstanding such Tender, the Sheriff shall take the Party der'd him, and tendering such Tobacco, or his her Goods in Execution, without sufexecuting the fering such Tobacco to be viewed, or allowing a reasonable Time for such View, not to exceed Ten Days, that in all such Cases, the Sheriff His penalty. Shall not only have no Fees, but also be liable to an Action of false Imprilonment, or Trespals, and to pay double Damages and Cost of Suit to the Party grieved; any Law, Ulage, or Custom to the contrary notwithstanding.
