And be it further Enacted, by the Authority aforesaid, That it shall and may be lawful for the Justices of Prince George's County, upon Application to them made by the Vestry of Prince George - Parish aforesaid, to cause to be levied in such manner as the Publick and County Levies ing a Church- are levied, upon the Taxable Persons in the said Parish, so much Toco for buildbacco as will enable the faid Parish to build a Church; so that the said Sum so to be levied for that Use do not exceed the Sum of Twenty Thousand Pounds of Tobacco; any Law, Statute, Usige or Custom to the contrary thereof notwithstanding.
