ACT to impower Commissioners to ap-. point and cause to be laid out Three Thousand Acres of Land on Broad-Passed October ? 23d, 1711. } Creek, in Somerset County, for the Use of the Nanticoke Indians, so long as they shall occupy the same.

BY this Act Commissioners are appointed to cause Three Thou-fand Acres of Land to be laid out for the Nanticoke Indians, where they are now settled in Somerset County, on Broad Creek in Nanricoke River, and the same to appoint to the Use of the said Indians, fo long as they shall occupy the same.

THE said Commissioners shall grant Warrant to the Sheriff, to impannel a Jury for valuing the Damage the Owners sustain, by appoint-

ing the faid Lands for the faid Indians.

THE Commissioners are also to cause the Lands to be surveyed and marked, and return Certificate of their having so done to the Clerk of the Provincial Court, and to the Somerset County Court, to be by them recorded in their said respective Courts.

THE Property of the laid Lands shall be vessed in the said Trustees and their Heirs, to and for the Use of the said Indians, so long as they

shall occupy the same.

THE Right of all Persons to the said Lands, is by the said A& declared to be barred; any Law, Statute or Usage to the Contrary notwithstanding.

ACT prohibiting the carrying of Liquors, to the Indian Towns or felling any Quantity of Liquors to the Indians, to Passed April? Quantity of Liquois to the Indians, to 26th, 1715. Sprevent Differences between them and His Majesty's Subjects; and to punish the Transporters of any Friend Indian or Indians out of the Province.

A NY Person or Persons whatsoever inhabiting or trading into the Province, who shall presume to carry any Liquor whatsoever to any Indian Town or Fort, or within Three Miles of such Town or Fort, and shall vend or dispose thereof to any Indian or Indians, shall forfeit Five Thousand Pounds Tobacco, the one half of said Fine to go for support of Government, and the other half to the Informer or Person, who will sue for the same.

No Person or Persons shall by themselves, Servants or otherwise, diseetly or indirectly, vend or sell to any Indian or Indians, in the Space
