THE half Quarters and other parts in Proportion to their Denomination, and light pieces in Proportion to their Weight; and the Currency of all other Silver Coins of the same or baser alloy, shall stand regulated according to their Weight and Fineness, according and in Proportion to the Rate before limited and set for Pieces of Eight of Seville, Pillar and Mexico.

THE Dollars commonly called Dog Dollars, shall pass at *Four Shillings* and *Six Pence* as usual, until such time as His Majesty, His Heirs and Successors, or the General Assembly of the Province shall otherwise ordain and enact.

Passed October } **ACT** prohibiting the Exportation of
 28th, 1712. } **Hides of Cattle tanned or untanned,**
or any old Iron.

IF any Person or Persons whatsoever, shall carry and transport or cause or endeavour to be carried or transported out of this Province, by Land or by Water, to any other of His Majesty's Plantations, any Skins or Hides of any neat Cattle tanned or untanned, or any old Iron whatsoever, it shall and may be lawful for any Officer of the Customs, to make seizure thereof; and the Master, Merchant or Owner of any Ship or Vessel, or other Person, being convicted of shipping or transporting the same by Land out of the Province, shall not only forfeit the same, but also the Sum of *Fifty Pounds* Currency; one half thereof for support of the Government, and the other half to the Informer or Suer for the same.

A Copy of this Act, for the better Publication thereof, is ordered to be affixed in every Naval Office, and the Officers of the Customs are required to have a strict Regard thereto.
