

such Executions, pursuant to the Directions in the above Act, as fully and effectually as if they had been therein mentioned.

*N. B.* THE Judgment confessed for a small Debt, before a single Justice obtained, must be returned to the County Clerk. The others to the respective Clerks of the Courts where the first Judgment was obtained.

*Passed 1728.* In the Supplementary ACT, for relieving from Aggrievances in Law Suits, the following Clauses relative to the above two Acts are contained.

THE Time in the aforesaid Acts mentioned for stay of Execution, shall be changed from the Tenth Day of November yearly, to the Tenth Day of February; and in the Confession by the said Acts required, the Words (on the Tenth Day of November shall be changed to the Words, (on the Tenth Day of February next.)

THIS Act is continued only for Three Years &c. But is from time to time continued till 1757 when it is renewed for Three Years and to the End of the next Session of Assembly thereafter.

*Passed July 11th, 1732.* } Supplementary ACT to the above Acts.

WHERE any Execution or Executions shall be issued any Year, before the Tenth Day of May, against the Body or Goods of any Person or Persons, who, when such Executions have issued, were not, nor shall be taken till after the Tenth Day of May; in all such Cases, it shall be lawful for them to supersede upon confessing Judgment as above directed, in the same Manner, as if the Execution had been issued after the Tenth Day of May.

*Passed April 26th, 1715.* } ACT for punishing the Offences of Adultery and Fornication.

WHOEVER shall directly or indirectly entertain, provide for or cause to be provided for, or entertained, any leu'd Woman or Women, or shall frequent her or their Companies, after Admonition by the Minister, Vestry or Church Warden or Wardens of the Parish, where such Person resides, shall be adjudged a Fornicator or Adulterer, as the Case shall be, and suffer such Penalties as by this Law are appointed.

EVERY Person convicted of Fornication, in the Provincial or County Courts, shall be fined *Thirty Shillings* current Money or *Six Hundred Pounds*
