

towards the Use of Free Schools in the County, and the other half to the Informer or Suer for the same.

EVERY Master, Mistress, Dame or other chief Person of a Family, concealing any Taxable, or not giving a true Account to the Constable pursuant to the Directions of the above Act, shall for every Taxable so concealed, forfeit *Five Hundred Pounds* of Tobacco, to be recovered as aforesaid.

No Person shall be taken as a Taxable, that shall not be imported into the Province, on or before the First Day of June for that Year.

ALL Warrants issued by the Justices of Peace, for the Recovery of small Debts, shall be directed to the Constable of the Hundred, appointed by the Courts, unless, at the Request of some Suitor, it be directed to some Friend, who shall serve it gratis, such Suitor paying nevertheless his Fee, to the Constable of the Hundred.

THE Sheriff shall be obliged yearly to return into the Secretary's Office, by the Twentieth of September, a true and fair List of the Taxables in his County, under his Hand, on pain of *One Thousand Pounds* of Tobacco, to be forfeited and recovered as above.

THE several Constables, are required to send a Copy of their List of Taxables to the Sheriff, at or before the First Day of August, yearly after their taking such List.

It shall and may be lawful for any Constable of a Hundred, upon finding any single Person or Free Man, who cannot procure some Housekeeper within the Hundred, to give him in as a Taxable, nor cannot make it appear, that he is a Resident, and taken as a Taxable in any other Hundred or County, to carry such free Person to the next Justice, who is empowered and required to commit him to the Sheriffs Custody, till he procures some Housekeeper to return him as a Taxable, and be answerable for his Levy.

Supplementary ACT to the afore recited
Passed June 2 Act, for the Appointment of Constables, &c.
3d, 1752. S

THE Clerk of every County Court, after the Appointment of Constables in such County, shall, within five Days after such Appointment, signify and deliver the same under his Hand, to the Sheriff of the said County, under the Penalty of *Twenty Shillings*, to be recovered before a single Magistrate, to the Use of the County. And the Sheriff shall, within Ten Days after such Delivery, deliver the same to each Person so appointed or leave the same at his usual Place of Residence, under the Forfeiture of *Twenty Shillings* current Money, to the Use, and to be recovered as aforesaid. And every Person so appointed, who shall not within five Days after Notice, qualify himself, by taking the Oaths by the said afore recited Act appointed, shall incur the Penalty mentioned in the said Act.
