

WHERE any Constable shall die or remove out of the County, either before or after his Qualification, or shall refuse or neglect to qualify, on his being appointed, then and in that Case, it shall and may be lawful for any two of the next Justices of Peace in the County, where such Death, Removal or Refusal happens, and they are by this Act required forthwith to appoint another proper Person, to be Constable in the Hundred in his Place; upon the Certificate of which Justices, the Person so appointed, upon delivering the same to him, shall within the Time before limited, qualify himself as above directed, and under the Pains and Penalties by this and the former Acts imposed.

ACT declaring female Mulatto's born,  
*Passed October 6th, 1725.* } of white Women and free Negro Women to be Taxables.

ALL female Mulatto's born of white Women and free Negro Women, of the Age of Sixteen Years, shall be accounted taxable Persons, and shall be subject and liable to all the Forfeitures and Penalties, other Taxables are subjected to, by the Laws of the Province made concerning them.

ACT for ordering and regulating the Militia of the Province, for the better  
*Passed April 26th, 1715* } Defence and Security thereof.

EVERY Colonel, Lieutenant Colonel, Major and Captain of Horse or Foot, already commissioned or who shall hereafter be commissioned, by the Governor for the Time being, shall have Power to enlist such and so many inhabiting within the Province, not hereafter excepted, in their several and respective Divisions, between Sixteen and Sixty Years of age, as they shall think fit; by as equal Proportions of the Inhabitants, as possibly they can, to be of the Militia or Train Bands of the Province.

THEY shall muster, exercise and train those enlisted, in and at such Places and at such certain Times, as to them shall seem meet, and as the Service, Safety or Defence of the Province requires, or as the Governor or Commander in Chief for the Time being, shall so cause, order and appoint.

EVERY such Colonel, Lieutenant Colonel, Major or Captain, shall give Notice or Summons, upon every training or mustering, to every Person enlisted, at the Head of the Company or at the House of the Party, by an Officer of his Company, or Warrant under his Hand, to appear at such time and place as he shall appoint, for such training and mustering; and if, after such Notice given, any Man shall neglect to appear at the Time and Place appointed, or shall, after appearing, refuse
