fuse to be inlisted, or, being inlisted, shall not from time to time as summoned or warned, appear and bring with him one good serviceable Gun fix'd, with Six Charges of Powder, shall for every such Offence (if a Freeman) forseit the Sum of One Hundred Pounds of Tobacco, and if a Servant, letted or hindered by his Master, Mistress or Overseer, then, such Master, Mistress or Overseer shall pay the like Sum of One Hundred Pounds of Tobacco, for each Servant so letted or hindered, for the Use of the Troop or Foot Company to which he belongs, to purchase Drums, Colours and other Necessaries for the Troop or Company, as the Field Officers or any two of them shall direct.

No Officer can press Arms or Ammunition for any further Service or Expedition, than training, but upon all such Occasions, they shall

be supplied out of the County Magazine or Store.

ALL the above Forfeitures shall be heard, adjudged and determined by the Colonel, Lieutenant Colonel, Major, or any two of them, and an Account thereof kept in writing, by the Clerk of such Troop or

Company.

THE Colonel, Lieutenant Colonel or Major of such County, or any two of them, are impowered to award Execution against the Body, Goods and Chattels of such Persons so neglecting, refusing or failing as aforesaid, and upon Occasion of all such Executions, the respective Clerks and Sheriffs of such respective County, shall issue out and serve Execution, without Fee or Reward.

THE Captain of Horse in each County, shall in list his number of Men for making up his Troop, out of the Inhabitants in the County, according to such Instructions, as he shall from time to time receive from the Governor or the Colonel for the County, for the Time being.

THE Troopers shall ride their own Horses, and no Person shall be a Trooper, unless Owner of a good serviceable Horse, that shall pass Muster, they shall be obliged also, to find themselves with good, able and sufficient Furniture for their Horses, with Swords, Carabines, Pistols, Holsters and Ammunition.

Ir the Troopers or any of them shall neglect or refuse, upon Notice given as aforesaid as to the Foot Soldiers, to appear or muster at the Time and Place appointed, accounted as aforesaid, they shall each torseit and pay One Hundred Pounds of Tobacco, to be levied as aforesaid, to the Use of the Troop, as the Commander shall think sit.

THE Troopers at all times, as they shall be out a Ranging, shall find their own Provisions, but when in actual Service, they are to be found at the Charge of the Publick; and any Troopers Horse, that shall happen to be killed in the Service, shall be paid for by the Publick.

ALL Persons in Holy Orders, Delegates, Magistrates and Constables, shall be exempted, during the Time of their Officiating, from serving in either Horse or Foot, all Negro's and Slaves are also exempted.

THE Pay for the Officers and Soldiers of the Foot and Horse aforesaid, shall not be other, than is after mentioned, and for no longer time, than in actual Service, viz.
