WHENEVER it shall appear to the Governor or Commander in Chief for the Time being and his Council, to be necessary to raise Forces for the Suppressing of any foreign Invasion or domestick Insurrection or Rebellion, or any War with the Indians, all the necessary Charges of fuch War and Soldiers Pay as aforefaid, shall be paid, discharged and defrayed by a publick Levy, by an equal Assessment upon the Taxables of the Province, by their Representatives in Assembly, or out of

the publick Treasury.

THE Commissioners of each respective County, shall yearly between the Twenty Ninth Day of September, and Twenty Fifth of December nominate and appoint two honest and substantial Men of their County to be Press Masters for the ensuing Year; and if any so named, die, depart the County or be lame or fick within that time, than the next Justice shall nominate and appoint another Press Master in his place; and they, and no other, shall impress Victuals and other Things given them in Charge to be pressed by the Governor or Commander in Chief, for the Time being. Any other, (except a Press Master) prefuming to seize, press or take away any thing, shall pay to the Party grieved, treble the Value of the Goods or Commodities fo pressed or taken away.

No Press Master shall, upon any Pretence whatever, press or take away any Arms or Ammunition, without express Orders from the Governor or Commander in Chief, for the Time being, under the Penalty aforesaid.
