

THE same additional Duty of *Twenty Shillings* Currency per Poll, shall be paid for every Negro imported, under the same Penalty, to be applied as above, in case of concealing any. Which additional Duties shall be applied towards the Encouragement of one publick School in every County within the Province.

Supplementary ACT to the Act, for laying an Imposition on Negros and Irish Papists Servants imported.
Passed October }
11th, 1720. }

THE Owners, Residenters in the Province, of every Ship or Vessel, in order to entitle them to be Duty free for Negros or *Irish* Servants imported, as provided for in the said original Act, shall be obliged at making Entry, or sometime before her Clearance, to take the following Oath, to be tendered by the Naval Officer.

YOU A. B. C, do swear, that you are the true and only Owners of the Ship—, and have continued so ever since the Time of purchasing the Register by you now produced, and that you have not purchased the said Vessel, nor obtained the Register aforesaid, to the Use of or in Trust for any other Person or Persons whatsoever, nor for the Sake of evading the Payment of any Duties, in favour of any Person or Persons whatsoever, that are not actual Residenters within the Province.

It is provided, that in case any of the Owners as above, depart the Province and go beyond Sea, and shall not be absent above Twelve Months, his Oath may be dispensed with, all the other Owners taking the same. And in case any Owner shall refuse to take the above Oath, no benefit shall be given by the Naval Officer, but the whole Owners shall stand on the same Footing as if Non Residenters.

ACT freeing and relieving the Inhabitants of the Province and others removing their Families from any other Counties or Colonies, to settle and inhabit in the Province, from paying the Duty on Negros and Irish Servants.

NO Person or Persons inhabiting or that shall import themselves and Families to settle in the Province, and shall have Occasion to bring
