decree to the Contrary, and shall in all things obey such Order and Decree, as the Chancery Court shall make in the Premisses, then the a ove Obligation to be wild and of none Effect, else to be in full Force and Virtue.

And such Bond, so given, shall be a sufficient Supersedeas to any surther Proceedings in that Case, until the Person against whom such Chancery Relief is proposed, shall obtain a Certificate from the Chancellor or his Register; of the Dissallowance of an Injunction in sull case, or that such Injunction has not been sued out of the Chancery Office within Two Months after such Cond given, or if sued out, that the same is dissolved.

It is provided, that the Commissioners and Evidences for their Service and Attendance, shall have and be intitled to the same Allowance as Justices and Evidences in the County Courts are, and that the same shall be levied in the same Manner as Officers Fees are.

Passed September 3 ACT to prevent the tumultuous Meetings of Negros and other Slaves.

HE Justices of the several and respective County Courts within the Province, are by this Act impowered and required yearly in November Court, to appoint the Constable of every Hundred, where the said Justices at their Discretion shall think proper and expedient, to suppress the Assembling and tumultuous Meeting of Negros and other Slaves; and every Constable, so to be appointed, shall be obliged to repair once every Month to all suspected Places, within his Hundred, and if at any such Place he shall find any Negros or other Staves belonging to the Owner of such Place, not having a Licence under their Owner or Overseers Hands, it shall and may be lawful for him, and he is by this Act required, to whip every such Negro on the bare Back, at his Discretion, not exceeding Thirty Nine Lashes.

Ir shall and may be lawful for the Constable to require as many Persons as may be necessary to repair with him to such Places; and every Person that shall be so required, and shall resuse, shall forfeit One Handred Pounds of Tobacco, to be recovered and applied as hereaster expressed; and all free Persons present, shall be obliged to assist, on pain of the like Forseiture, one half to the Use of the County, the other half to the Informer, on Conviction, by the Oath of the Constable or other lawful Witness, or Consession of the Party before any Magistrate; and all Negros belonging to the Owner of the Place, where such Assembly shall be, shall, if required, aid and assist the Constable
