

Three Thousand Pounds of said Fund was appropriated for building a House for the Governor; *Five Hundred Pounds* of said Fund for each County, for building convenient Gaols near the Court House; and *Five Hundred Pounds* more was applied towards repairing the publick Buildings.

AFTER the above Circulation, what remained in the Commissioners Hands was ordered to be lent out on Interest at *Four per Cent*; and new Bills were ordered to be given in Exchange for old, torn or defaced Bills.

WHATEVER part of the *Ninety Thousand Pounds* remained in the Office, at the End of One Year, more than what should be necessary to defray the Charges of the Office, and the above Appropriations, was ordered to be remitted to *London*, to Trustees there appointed.

IT is declared lawful for the Commissioners to lend out upon Security of good Plate, at the Rate of *Five Shillings* Currency per Ounce; which if not redeemed within One Year, was ordered to be sold, and the Overplus repaid to the Owners.

As a Fund for sinking the said Bills of Credit, there is a Duty of *One Shilling and Three Pence* Sterling imposed on every Hoghead of Tobacco, or *Four Hundred Pounds* of Tobacco in Chest or Case, exported out of the Province, to be paid to the Naval Officers; but if the Tobacco, for which the Duty is so paid, should happen to be lost, the Owner may export afterwards the Quantity lost, Duty free.

WHICH Duty is to be remitted to the Trustees at *London*, as also the Interest arising on Loans, and there laid out in purchasing Bank Stock, the Trustees being allowed *Two and a half per Cent* for negotiating.

AFTER Fifteen Years, a Third of the said Bills of Credit were ordered to be paid off.

ITS declared by this Act, Felony and punished with Death, to counterfeit any of the said Bills of Credit, or to pass any of them, knowing them to be counterfeited.

ACT for raising and issuing Money for maintaining his Majesty's Forces, to be raised in the Province, and for transporting them to the Place of Rendezvous in *West-Indies*.
