

ACT for granting a Supply of Forty  
 Thousand Pounds for His Majesty's  
 Service, and striking Thirty Four  
 Thousand and Fifteen Pounds Six  
 Shillings thereof in Bills of Credit,  
 and raising a Fund for sinking the  
 same.

Passed February  
 2<sup>d</sup>, 1756. }

BY this Act, *Four Thousand and Fifteen Pounds Six Shillings*, then signed in the Paper Office, is ordered to be circulated, and to stand on the same Credit as the Bills emitted and made current by the Act for emitting *Ninety Thousand Pounds* current Money in Bills of Credit are; and the Commissioners are ordered and directed to pay out of any other Bills of Credit in their Hands *Five Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty Four Pounds Fourteen Shillings*.

*Thirty Four Thousand and Fifteen Pounds* in Bills of Credit are ordered to be struck in the Form and under the Regulations upon the Trustees, contained in the said principal Act.

It is declared Felony to counterfeit said Bills, or to offer the same in Payments, knowing them to be counterfeited. And all Magistrates and other Persons, into whose Hands such Counterfeit Bills may happen to come, shall forthwith deliver the same to one of the Commissioners or Trustees, who shall cause the Name of those that delivered them, and of the Person from whom they were taken, to be indorsed on the Back of them.

THESE Bills to be struck are declared to pass current in all Payments, in the same Manner as the Bills of Credit do, already emitted and made current by the Act for emitting and making current *Ninety Thousand Pounds* in Bills of Credit.

THE Commissioners or Trustees of the Loan Office, after the Sum of *Five Thousand Nine Hundred and Eighty Four Pounds Fourteen Shillings* above directed to be paid and delivered out, is repaid and replaced in the Office, shall retain and keep in the said Office all such Sums as they shall receive in Consequence of this Act, except such Part thereof as shall be exchanged for torn or defaced Bills; and all torn or defaced Bills so taken in Exchange until the next Session of Assembly and then burn and destroy the same in presence of the Committee appointed to inspect the Accounts of the said Office, and so from Session to Session, until they have so destroyed the full Sum of *Thirty Four Thousand and Fifteen Pounds Six Shillings*.
