ACT for erecting *Ann Arundel* and *Oxford* Towns into Ports and Towns

Petitionary Act for Free-Schools

Act for keeping good Rules and Orders, in the Port of *Annapolis*

MARCH 16, 170 $\frac{1}{2}$.

Act for laying an Imposition on several Commodities exported out of the Province.

The first Part of this Act laying a Duty on Furs, is repealed by Act passed September 23d. 1723. The Residue is still in Force and inserted in the abridgment.

Act to make valid Good and Effectual in Law, all process from 1690 to 1692, and till the arrival of Governor *Nicholson*.

Act against Ingrossers and Regraters, repealed 1729, and the Act then substitute in its Place, is again repealed *March 20th, 1734*.

Act confirming Purchases made by the Commissioners of the respective Counties, in Virtue of a former Act, for the use of their Court-Houses.

DECEMBER 5th, 1734.

Act for the Preservation of the several Harbours and Landing places within the Province, repealed *March 20, 1734*, when re-enacted.

APRIL 2d, 1706.

Act for Encouragement of the making Hemp and Flax within the Province.

This Act and all subsequent Acts relative thereto expire 1734, being only continued down from Time to Time till that Year.
