

TUESDAY, January 13, 1818.

The house met. Present the same members as on yesterday The proceedings of yesterday were read. The bill making public a parcel of ground at the junction of Bridge and Harford streets in the city of Baltimore; the bill to open and extend Pine-street in the western part of the city of Baltimore, and the bill for the relief of William Hackett of Queen Anne's county, were sent to the senate.

The report on the petition of the heirs of General John Davidson was read the second time, and the question put, That the house concur therewith and assent to the resolution therein contained? The yeas and nays being required appeared as follow:

So it was determined in the negative.

The clerk of the senate delivers the supplement to the act, entitled, An act authorising a lottery to raise a sum of money for building a Masonic Hall in Elkton Cecil county, and the supplement to an act, entitled, An act to lay out and open a road in Cecil county, severally endorsed, will pass. Ordered to be engrossed. Also a bill, entitled, An act to provide for the opening and extension of Pratt-street in the city of Baltimore, endorsed, passed by the senate January 12, 1818; which was read, and on motion by Mr. Wilson, the question was put, That the said bill be made the order of the day for Tuesday next? Determined in the negative.

On motion by Mr. Wilson, the question was then put, That the said bill be made the order of the day for Friday next? Resolved in the affirmative.

On motion by Mr. Murray, Ordered, That the said bill be printed for the use of the members.

Mr. Murray delivers a bill, entitled, An additional supplement to the act, entitled, An act for the relief of the poor in the counties of Somerset and Dorchester, passed in seventeen hundred and eighty-five, and the several supplements thereto; which was read the first and second time by special order and passed.

Mr. Downey delivers a bill, entitled, An act authorising a lottery or lotteries to raise a sum of money for building a Masonic Hall and Church in New Market Frederick county; which was read.

Mr. Saulsbury delivers a bill, entitled, An act for the relief of the poor of Caroline county; which was read.

The supplement to the act, entitled An act to prevent the inconveniencies arising from slaves being permitted to act as free, was read the second time, amended, passed, and sent to the senate.

The house resumed the further consideration of the bill, entitled, An act to establish a bank and incorporate a company, under the name of The Frederick Town and County Bank. On motion by Mr. Forrest, the question was put, That the blank in the first section of the bill relative to the amount of capital said bank be filled up with five hundred thousand dollars? Determined in the negative.

On motion by Mr. Forrest, the question was then put, That the said blank be filled up with four hundred thousand dollars? Determined in the negative.

On motion by Mr. Blakistone, the question was then put, That the said blank be filled up with three hundred thousand dollars? Determined in the negative.

On motion by Mr. Long, the question was put, That the first section of the bill be stricken out, viz. Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Maryland, That a Bank to be called and known by the name

The Frederick-Town and County Bank, shall be established in Frederick-town, the capital stock of which shall consist of — dollars, money of the United States, to be divided into shares of — dollars each? The yeas and nays being required appeared as follow:
