FRIDAY, December 31, 1819.

The house met. Present the same members as on yesterday. The proceedings of yesterday were read.

The clerk of the senate delivers a communication from the executive, enclosing an annual report from the inspectors of the penitentiary; which was read. And the bill to incorporate the trustees of the Federal Hill Sunday School, endorsed "will pass." Ordered to be engrossed.

Mr. Blakistone delivers a bill, entitled, An act for the relief of Ann Branson and Ally Buckler, of Saint-Mary's county; which was read the first and second time by special order, and passed.

On motion by Mr. W. R. Stuart, the following resolution was read and assented to:

Resolved, That the treasurer of the western shore pay to his excellency the governor, or his order, the residue of the sum now remaining in the treasury, appropriated under a resolution of the last session, for the purpose of furnishing the government house.

Mr. Hayward presents a petition from sundry inhabitants of Talbot county, praying that all donations heretofore granted to the several academies of this state, may be withdrawn, and applied to the education of poor children generally; which was read and referred to Messrs. Hayward, Dorsey, Duvall, W. R. Stuart, Boyle, Key and Blakistone.

Mr. Forwood presents a petition from sundry inhabitants of Harford county, of a similar nature; which was read and ordered to lie on the table.

Mr. Hayward presents a petition from James Nicholson of Talbot county, praying a special act of insolvency; which was read and referred to Messrs. Hayward, D. Martin and Stevens.

Mr. Hayward presents a petition from Edward N. Hambleton, praying that a suit between him and Samuel Tenant may be reinstated in the court of appeals; which was read and referred to Messrs. Hayward, D. Martin and Stevens.

On the second reading of the resolution relative to the pay of the witnesses from Calvert, on motion by Mr. Spencer, the question was put, That the first blank be filled up with the words "eight dollars?" The yeas and nays being required appeared as follow:
